C I R C U L A R

Sub : Regarding verification of genuineness of certificates with reference to qualification.

Investigations conducted recently into certain complaint received by the Directorate of Vigilance have revealed that some Candidates have secured jobs in a Government Department by producing fake certificates/documents at the time of recruitment.

In order to ensure that such cases are not prevalent elsewhere in other departments, it is considered necessary that the Heads of Departments and Appointing Authorities should carry out verification of the genuineness of Certificates showing the essential qualifications of candidates appointed in Government departments recently i.e. appointed after January 1990.

All the Heads of Departments are therefore requested to carry out such an exercise and take appropriate action in consultation with Director (Vigilance) - in cases, where malpractices have been noticed and persons have been appointed on the basis of forged/false documents.

The action taken in this regard be intimated to the Director of Vigilance, at an early date.
