**NOTIFICATION**

The Government of Goa is hereby pleased to amend the Goa Government General Pool Residential Accommodation Allotment Rules, 1995, as follows:-

1. Short title and Commencement – (1) These rules may be called the Goa Government General Pool Residential Accommodation Allotment (Fourth Amendment) Rules, 2001.  
(2) They shall come into force at once.
2. Amendment of rule 6 – In rule 6 of the Goa Government General Pool Residential Accommodation Allotment Rules, 1995 (hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Rules"), in sub-rule (1), the following paragraph shall be added namely:-

"A Separate list of employees of the Central Government and Accredited Journalists shall be maintained. They shall also submit their applications through the Head of Office/Employer, as the case may be, in the specified form. The Allotting Authority shall make a separate list classwise of such employees".


3. Amendment of rule 7 – In rule 7 of the principal Rules; after clause (ix), the following shall be inserted, namely:-  
"(x) maximum of 10% flats of C, D and E Category will be reserved to Central Government staff and maximum of 5% flats will be reserved to Accredited Journalists.
4. Insertion of new rule 7A – After rule 7 of the principal Rules, the following rules shall be inserted namely:-

"7A. Discretionary Allotment – 20% flats in A,B,C,D and E category shall be allotted at the discretion of the Hon. Chief Minister".

5. Amendment of rule 18 – In rule 18 of the principal Rules, the following paragraph shall be added namely:-

“Journalists who are no more Accredited should immediately surrender their residential accommodation to the Government. Such journalists shall have no right for allotment of General Pool Accommodation. Further, in case of availability of vacant residential accommodation in the quota allotted to the journalists, a request from the Editor or Chief Editor may be considered by the Government”.
