

## **CM ASSURES PLACEMENT FOR REMAINING CFF BY JANUARY 26, 2024"**

He was speaking as the Chief Guest after unfurling the tri color at the 63<sup>rd</sup> Goa Liberation Day function held at Goa University Ground in Taleigao **today**.

Chief Minister further expressed that the Government's dedicated endeavors are channeled towards the realization of the "Antoday, Sarvoday, Gramoday" vision, aimed at shaping Goa into a Golden state.
