

## **CM LAYS FOUNDATION STONE FOR NEW OFFICE FOR INSPECTORATE OF FACTORIES & BOILERS**

Chief Minister informed that the Goa State Infrastructure Development Corporation (GSIDC) Ltd would undertake the 10-crore project, slated for completion within two years.
