With reference to the aforementioned Circular and Letter, it has come to our attention that many State Government websites are not being updated in a timely manner. They often contain obsolete information, have invalid security audits/SSL certifications, and do not comply with GIGW guidelines.

The failure to adhere to these communications has hindered effective monitoring of these websites.

To address this issue systematically, the Government has appointed SDA - M/s GEL to oversee all website-related activities including design, development, hosting, security/STQC audit, GIGW compliance, maintenance, and monitoring.

In light of the above, all Government departments are once again requested to comply with the instructions outlined in the aforementioned circular within 60 days of issue of this circular. This applies to all departments, corporations, autonomous bodies, and institutions.

This compliance is essential to enhance website security and will also facilitate seamless monitoring of all State Government websites through SDA oversight.
