Whereas the fish landing in the State of Goa takes place at various major landing centres as well as traditional landing centres (Ramps).

And whereas it has become necessary to monitor all fish landing ramps in the State and restrict the number of landing centres in the State from the point of view of Coastal Security.

And whereas it has been recommended by the Coastal Security Co-ordination Committee that the State Government may designate the existing fish landing ramps by notifying the same as not allow fish landing at any landing centres other than above notified.

And whereas the Government has therefore decided to make it mandatory for the fishing canoes to land their fish only on the notified landing ramps beside traditional beach landing.

Now therefore the Government hereby notifies, at the first instance, the following fish landing ramps in the State of Goa as fish landing centres for the traditional fishing canoes from the State of Goa.
