Ref.: Notification No. 2/1/2001-HD(G) dated 25-5-2012 published in Official Gazette, Series I No. 9 dated 31-5-2012.

The Government vide Notification referred above had revised the payment of casino fees. However, in order to remove doubts in the matter, the Government of Goa hereby issues clarification/guidelines as under:—

1. The Annual Recurring Fees (ARF) notified vide Notification No. 2/1/2001-HD(G) dated 25-05-2012 is effective only from the date on which it is due, to be collected/paid.

2. Those who do not pay on the due date, the licensing authority shall issue 'stop operations' orders. Upon such intimation, the Commercial Tax Department shall stop issuing coupons/entry tickets to defaulting casinos. A suitable notice shall be put on the website of Commercial Taxes and Secretariat alongwith press announcements to warn the public.

3. The operations of a defaulting casino can be resumed with effect from the date of payment of ARF and the operations can be carried out by such casino for the next one year period w.e.f. date of payment of ARF provided that the licence issued to the casino is valid during the period of operations. Otherwise, the ARF shall be paid for the remaining period of licence proportionately. While calculating the proportionate fees, periods less than a month shall be treated as a whole month.

4. Those casinos which did not make payments on the due date prior to issue of notification No. 2/1/2001-HD(G) dated 25-05-2012, they shall stop all operations forthwith and the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes shall not issue coupons/entry tickets to such defaulting casinos.

They are liable for forfeiture of their security deposit also.

They shall be allowed to resume their operations provided:

- (i) their licence is valid or renewed.
- (ii) fresh security deposit is paid.
- (iii) deposit the ARF at the revised rates.

5. The land based casinos shall be allowed to pay the ARF in quarterly installments during current financial year only, subject to condition that ARF paid quarterly are always in advance and are paid with 12% interest for delayed part of payment.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of the existing Recruitment Rules for the post of B. C. G. Technician (re-designated as Pulmonary Function Testing Technician), notified vide Government Notification No. 1-31-74-Div.I (Vol.III) dated 12-12-1978, in the Official Gazette Series I No. 44 dated 01-02-1979, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Group 'C', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted post, in the Goa Medical College, Government of Goa, namely:—

1: *Short title, application and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Goa Medical College, Group 'C', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted post, Recruitment Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").

(3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number, classification and scale of pay.*— The number of posts, classification of the said post and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts specified in column (2) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.
