

FDA CONDUCTS FOOD INSPECTION DRIVE AT SALCETE

Panaji : March 10, 2025

Directorate of Food and Drugs Administration conducted a routine inspection drive at Salcete taluka today, wherein around 05 units were found manufacturing and packing of fryums and namkeen without valid food licence and under unhygienic conditions. Namkeen manufacturing unit was inspected during visit.

The final food packets did not possess any label declaration as per FSSAI packaging and labeling regulation. Around 80 kgs of Fryums, coloured pipes (namkeen) approximately worth Rs. 96,000/- were detained from the above units which were destroyed by officials in the interest of public health.

The above manufacturers were also directed to stop the food business activities. The said inspection was conducted under the guidance of Designated Officer South Goa Smt. Sanjyot Kudalkar and Food Safety Officials, Smt. Priya, Shri. Madhav, Shri. Amardeep and DFDA staff Shri. Sainath and Shri. Sandeep. The said drive was conducted under the leadership of DFDA, Smt. Shweta Dessai.
