

**CAMPAIGN REGARDING SCHEMES FOR WELFARE OF TRIBAL  
COMMUNITIES FROM JUNE 15-30**

**Panaji : May 15, 2025**

Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) activities will be conducted from June 15 to 30, 2025 regarding the Government of India's initiated Pradhan Mantri Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM JANMAN) and the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA), which focuses on 25 interventions through convergence of 17 line ministries to ensure holistic development of India's Tribal communities. The mission covers 26 States and 4 Union Territories. The Office of the Collector, South Goa District, has urged citizens of the South Goa District to obtain the benefits of this Abhiyan.

The campaign will involve on- the-ground service delivery through village and cluster level camp, offering Aadhar Card, Ration Card, Ayushman Bharat Card, Caste Certificate, PM-KISAN and Jan Dhan Account etc.

The basic amenities covered under Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DA JGUA), include Sabko Pucca Ghar, Har Ghar Nal Se Jal, Gaon-Gaon Tak Sadak, Har Ghar Bijli Har Ghar Bijli (Solar), Shiksha Ke Liye Hostel, Door Daraz Gaon Tak Mobile Medical Unit, Ayushman Bharat, Free LPG connection, Sabko Poshan, Poshan Vatika, Door Daraz Gaon Tak Mobile Network, Kaushal Vikas, Digital Initiatives, Sustainable Agriculture, PM Matsya Sampada Yojana, National Livestock Mission, Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA), Swadesh Darshan, Multi-purpose Marketing Centres, Ashram Schools/Hostel/Govt. Residential School, setting up of Centre of Competencies for Sickle Cell Anaemia and Forest Right Act (2006).

The initiative of the Abhiyan is to ensure saturation of services and infrastructure in tribal area through targeted intervention which is a transformative initiative reaffirming India's commitment to empowering its tribal communities. By addressing critical gaps and fostering socio-economic development, the program lays the foundation for a sustainable and inclusive future.
