The Office of the Collector, North has informed that the Government of India has initiated the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA). The Camp will be held on June 14, 2025 from 09:30 am onwards in the Office of Deputy Collector Sattari for disposal of FRA claims as endeavored by Chief Minister.

The aforesaid Abhiyan focuses on 25 interventions through convergence of 17 line ministries to ensure holistic development of India's tribal communities.

The Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan is a transformative initiative that reaffirms India's commitment to empowering its tribal communities.
