

## **CM DISTRIBUTES GOVT APPOINTMENT LETTERS AT ROJGAR MELAVA**

Chief Minister Dr. Pramod Sawant today reaffirmed the Government's commitment to providing employment opportunities for the youth of Goa, announcing that 5,000 youth will be inducted into Government jobs through the Goa Human Resource Development Corporation over the next two years.
