O R D E R

Read:- Order No. 16/1/96-RG(3589)  
dated 3-7-1998.

The Government is pleased to constitute the following two Committees, comprising the following Officers, one for the North Goa District and the other for the South Goa District, for examination of each case of reference or appeal under the Land Acquisition Act for enhancement of compensation and to decide on the Government's stand on the increase of the compensation in each case before the Lok Adalats:-

A. NORTH GOA DISTRICT.

- 1. The Collector, North Goa District, Panaji. ... Chairman
- 2. The Representative of the acquiring Department. ... Member
- 3. The representative of the District Registrar. ... Member.

B. SOUTH GOA DISTRICT.

- 1. The Collector, South Goa District, Margao. ... Chairman
- 2. Representative of the acquiring Department. ... Member
- 3. The representative of the District Registrar. ... Member.

The following may be considered by the Collectors as broad guiding principles, while determining the appropriate rates:-


- 1. If any other matter under the same notification or similar to it has already been settled before the High Court/Lok Nyayalaya, the enhancement award in that matter could be agreed in the case before the Lok Adalat.
- 2. If any matter under the same notification or similar to it has already been settled in the District Court and if no appeal has been preferred in the High Court, then the same enhancement could be agreed for the case before the Lok Adalat.
- 3. If any matter under same notification is disposed by the District Court and it is intended to file an appeal in the High Court, then upto 50% of enhancement awarded by the District Court may be considered for settling the matter before Lok Adalat.

4. If no other case under same notification is settled by the District Court then maximum enhancement of 25% over the L.A.O's award may be agreed.

In case the amount of compensation calculated as per the recommendation of the Committee exceeds Rs. 25 lakhs, then the matter shall be referred to the Revenue Department for decision.

The order dated 3-7-1998 read above, is hereby resounded.

Sub:- Proposal for enhanced compensation as suggested by Lok Adalat in Land Acquisition case.

Sir

I am directed to communicate as under:-

1. That the Revenue Department has been receiving for approval, several land Acquisition reference cases which are placed before the Lok Adalat for settlement & wherein the Lok Adalat panel proposes a rate which is higher than the rate recommended by the Government committee set up for examining such reference cases before Lok Adalat
2. The Acquiring Departments are instructed not to forward any proposals for enhancement of awarded rate in Land Acquisition cases for approval of the Revenue Department unless there is administrative and financial approval from the parent Department for such proposals from the Lok Adalat.

The Departments are requested to strictly follow the above instruction.
