

CM DISTRIBUTES "MHAJE GHAR YOJANA" FORMS AT MAYEM & BICHOLIM

The Chief Minister Dr. Pramod Sawant reiterated that the distribution of forms under Mhaje Ghar Scheme is Government's historic land/housing reforms. The Chief Minister appealed to the people to avail the benefits of this scheme.

Chief Minister Dr. Pramod Sawant officially launched the 'Mhaje Ghar' Yojana awareness campaign and began the distribution of application forms from the Mayem constituency. Later the form distribution ceremony was held in Bicholim.

Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah had recently unveiled Goa's 'Mhaje Ghar' Yojana at a ceremony held in Taleigao, intending to legalize built homes and confer ownership rights on long-standing Goan residents.

The forms distribution functions were organized at V. P. Mayem, Vaiginim And Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Government Primary School at Bicholim.

Chief Minister said, Mhaje Ghar scheme will help to reduce conflicts in the villages. The forms will be made available shortly in all panchayats and Deputy Collector offices, he informed.

Chief Minister portrayed the scheme in a very professional manner and answered the queries raised by the villagers. The Chief Minister informed that nine types of different forms are made available at the venues. The Chief Minister also mentioned that the house repair certificate and house separation certificate will be given to the applicants within three days and seven days respectively.

While speaking Shri Sadanand Shet Tanawade congratulated the Chief Minister and said that the land revenue reforms will provide security and stability to the Goans. He appealed to follow proper procedure to take advantage of this scheme.

Speaking on the occasion Shri Premendra Shet said, the land and housing reforms are aimed to distribute land ownership forms to benefit farmers, tenants and marginalized communities. He thanked the Chief Minister for these reforms.
