The following draft Rules, which the Government of Goa proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 199 read with Section 108A of the Goa Land Revenue Code, 1968 (Act 9 of 1969), so as to amend the Goa Land Revenue (Issuance of Identification and Corresponding Certificate) Rules, 2018, are hereby pre-published as required by sub-section (3) of Section 199 of the said Code for information of all the persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft Rules will be taken into consideration by the Government after expiry of a period of fifteen days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

All objections and/or suggestions to the said draft Rules may be forwarded to the Secretary (Revenue) to the Government of

Goa, Revenue Department, Secretariat, Porvorim-Goa, before the expiry of the said period of fifteen days so that they may be taken into consideration at the time of finalization of the said draft Rules.

DRAFT RULES

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (2) of Section 199 read with Section 108A of the Goa Land Revenue Code, 1968 (Act 9 of 1969) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to amend the Goa Land Revenue (Issuance of Identification and Corresponding Certificate) Rules, 2018, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Land Revenue (Issuance of Identification and Corresponding Certificate) (Amendment) Rules, 2025.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Amendment of rule 5.*— In rule 5 of the Goa Land Revenue (Issuance of Identification and Corresponding Certificate) Rules, 2018 (hereinafter referred as “principal Rules”), in sub-rule (1), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

“Provided that such fees shall not be applicable to the Government Departments for issuance of identification and correspondence certificate to them.”

3. *Amendment of rule 6.*— In rule 6 of the principal Rules, for clauses (i) and (ii) the following clauses shall be respectively substituted namely:—

“(i) For an area admeasuring 2,500 sq. mts. or for one holding irrespective of area, — ₹ 2,500/-.

(ii) For every additional area admeasuring 500 sq. mts. or part thereof — ₹ 1,000/-.”
