In exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 9 of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 (Act No. 2 of 1899), as in force in the State of Goa, the Government of Goa hereby permits the Life

Insurance Corporation of India, Goa Divisional Office, Panaji (hereinafter referred to as the “LIC Goa”) to pay consolidated stamp duty of Rs. 25,00,000/- (Rupees twenty five lakhs only), chargeable on sums to be insured in the insurance policies issued by its offices in the State of Goa with effect from 1st January, 2025 up to 31st December, 2025 in lieu of affixing stamps upon individual insurance policies, which has been paid vide cheque No. 000846 dated 28/04/2025, drawn on HDFC Bank, Panaji, Goa, subject to the following conditions, namely:-

- (a) In case the stamp duty chargeable on the insurance policies issued during the above mentioned period falls short of the stamp duty consolidated herein and paid to the Government, the excess consolidated stamp duty shall be adjusted for the next calendar year 2026.
- (b) In case the stamp duty chargeable on the insurance policies issued during the above period exceeds the stamp duty consolidated herein and paid to the Government, the balance amount due towards the stamp duty shall be paid to the Government Treasury by the LIC Goa latest by the first week of January, 2026.
- (c) A detailed report of the total stamp duty charged on the sum insured in the insurance policies issued by the offices of the LIC Goa in the State of Goa during the above period shall be submitted to the Secretary (Revenue), Revenue Department, Government of Goa, on or before 31/12/2025.

The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India launched the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban 2.0 (PMAY-U 2.0)—‘Housing for All’ Mission for urban areas will be implemented for 5 years from 01.09.2024 to provide Central Assistance to all eligible beneficiaries/households/implementing agencies through States/Primary Lending Institutions (PLIs) to construct, purchase or rent a house at an affordable cost.

The Mission will be implemented as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) except for the component of the Interest Subsidy Scheme (ISS) which will be implemented as a Central Sector Scheme. The Scheme will be implemented through the following four verticals:

- (i) Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC)
- (ii) Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP)
- (iii) Affordable Rental Housing (ARH)
- (iv) Interest Subsidy Scheme (ISS)
