The Directorate of Tribal Welfare, Government of Goa is implementing the scheme "Prashikshan Yatra-Scheme to provide financial assistance for conducting study tours (Excursion) for ST students during vacations".

Whereas Government desires to amend the scheme Clause 3, Clause 4, Clause 5, Clause 6 & Clause 8 in public interest.

Now therefore the amendment to Clause 3 sub-clause d (1) & (2), Clause 4, Clause 5 sub-clause (xi), Clause 6 sub-clause (b) and Clause 8, in scheme "Prashikshan Yatra-scheme to provide financial assistance for conducting study tours (Excursion) for ST students during vacations" is amended to read as under:—

*Clause 3 sub-clause d (1) & (2)*

*Benefit under the scheme.*— Financial assistance to the Educational Institutes for an amount up to Rs. 2.00 lakhs to conduct study tours/excursions and will cover following expenditure.
