

“Painting Exhibition 2026” submission date extended

Panaji: January 20, 2026

The Directorate of Art and Culture, extended the submission date for the "Painting Exhibition 2026" by rescheduling it on 23rd January 2026. The theme of the exhibition "Vibrant 25 years of Lokotsav" is based on the art and culture depicting the folk life in various forms. The exhibition is being organized to contribute towards the 25th year celebration of the national level folk dance festival "Lokotsav 2026" at Kala Academy, Campal, Panaji in collaboration with the West Zone Cultural Centre, Udaipur, Rajasthan.

The best three artworks will be awarded with the cash prize of Rs.10,000/- each based on the selection made by the judges. All the fine artists are invited to participate in the exhibition to demonstrate their creativity through visual paintings/artworks on the theme "Vibrant 25 years of Lokotsav". The painting/artwork for the exhibition will have to be the size of minimum 1.5ft to maximum 2.5ft with mounting, framing and hanging arrangements for the display. Only the selected paintings (ready for display) will be exhibited considering the area for the display in the art gallery.

The "Painting Exhibition 2026" will provide an opportunity to the Goan artists to present their talent in the visual form to the art lovers and for sale during the event by the respective artist. Artists will have to submit their work on 23rd January 2026 during office hours in the Art Gallery at Kala Academy, Campal, Panaji.
