

MEGA JOB FAIR 2026 TO OPEN NEW EMPLOYMENT PATHWAYS FOR GOA'S YOUTH ON JUNE 14

Panaji: June 13, 2026

A major employment and recruitment initiative aimed at connecting job seekers with industry opportunities will be held through Mega Job Fair 2026 on JUNE 14, 2026, at Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Indoor Stadium, St. Cruz, from 10:00 a.m. onwards. Organised by the Labour & Employment Department, Government of Goa, the event seeks to provide a common platform for employers and aspiring candidates while supporting employment generation and workforce development across the State.

Creating a bridge between talent and opportunity, the Mega Job Fair will bring together around 150 companies and is expected to attract nearly 10,000 job seekers and career aspirants. Employment opportunities will be available across a diverse range of sectors, including Aviation, Hospitality, Manufacturing, Retail, Healthcare, Automobile, Construction & Infrastructure, Security & Facility Management, Telecom & Communication, Information Technology & Software, Advertising, Marketing & Public Relations, Mechanical Engineering, E-Commerce & Digital Platforms, Education & Training, Banking & Financial Services, and Electrical & Electronics. Participation is open to candidates from all academic disciplines, including Science, Commerce, and Arts.

Building on a strong track record of employment facilitation, the Labour & Employment Department has organised 12 Job Fairs to date, through which 1,969 candidates were offered employment opportunities. In addition, 117 Placement Drives have resulted in 808 job offers, while the recently organised State-level Career Conclave provided career guidance, entrepreneurship awareness, and employment-related information to over 5,000 students and youth. The upcoming Mega Job Fair will cater to both fresh job seekers entering the workforce and experienced professionals seeking career advancement or new opportunities.

More than a recruitment platform, the Mega Job Fair reflects the Government's continued commitment towards empowering youth through employment, skills, and economic opportunity. By bringing together employers, industry representatives, and job seekers under one roof, the event aims to strengthen workforce participation, support career growth, and contribute towards Goa's vision of inclusive and sustainable development.
