

**NEW CAPTAIN OF PORTS TERMINAL BUILDING TO BE INAUGURATED
ON JUNE 08**

Goa State Infrastructure Development Corporation (GSIDC), as a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) has been set up for speedy implementation of all the infrastructural projects. Adding to this list of works, GSIDC has constructed the “Captain of Ports Terminal Building at Panaji which will be inaugurated by Shri Sarbananda Sonowal, Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Government of India on JUNE 08, 2026 in the presence of Chief Guest Dr. Pramod Sawant, Chief Minister, presided by Shri Digambar Kamat, Minister for Captain of Ports, Public Works Department and Legal Metrology, Shri Atanasio Monserrate, Minister for Revenue, Labour and Employment and Waste Management, Shri Michael Lobo, MLA, Calangute Constituency and Chairman, GSIDC Ltd., and other dignitaries.

The new administrative building for the Captain of Ports has been developed as a G+3 structure on the riverfront, ensuring enhanced monitoring and navigation control. The building constitutes a ship-shaped architectural theme and incorporates modern facilities. The total built up area is 4,405.00 sq.m. and the cost of project is Rs. 48.87 Crore. The building rests on pile foundation and is a composite structure comprising both structural steel and reinforced concrete components. In line with Departmental requirements, provision has been made for an amphitheatre with seating and a restaurant. This facility is expected to generate additional revenue for the Captain of Ports Department if rented or leased.
