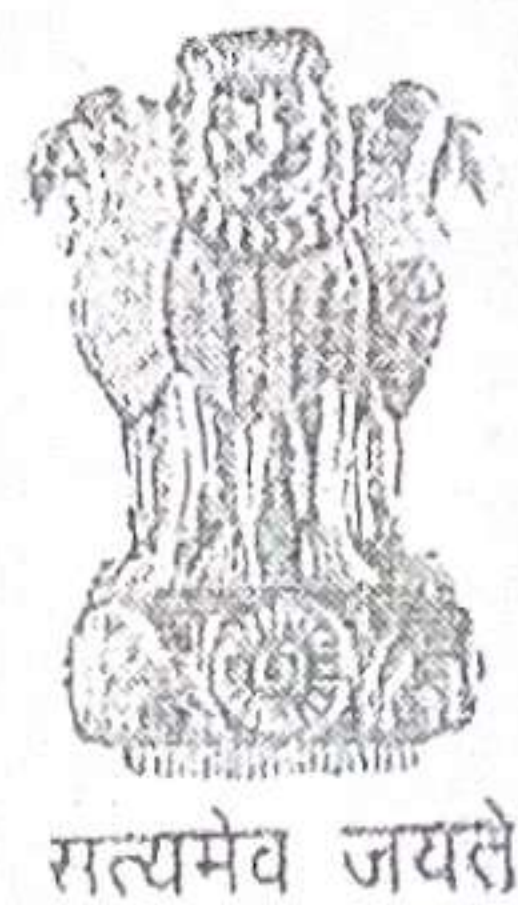

Subject: Adoption and Integration of Entity Locker and API Setu platforms.

This is with reference to the D.O. letter No. (229/2026-IT/Telecom) dated 08.04.2026 received from Shri Rajiv Gauba, Member, NITI Aayog, Govt. of India.

2. A High-Level Committee (HLC) on Non-Financial Regulatory Reforms (NFRR) has been constituted to drive reforms in digital governance, regulatory simplification and ease of doing business. After extensive consultations with Ministries, Departments and industry stakeholders, the HLC identified Digitization as a priority area and recommended adoption of Digital Public Infrastructures (DPIs) such as **Entity Locker** and **API Setu** by all Central and State Ministries/Departments to transform online government service delivery.

3. National e-Governance Division (NeGD), an Independent Business Division under MeitY, has been assigned with the responsibility for development and management of following platforms-

- **Entity Locker** - An enterprise level digital locker system from MeitY, for organizations to securely store, manage, share, and verify their official digital documents, thus promoting paperless governance.
- **API Setu** - Industry-standard API Platform from MeitY, developed referring to OpenAPI Specification (OAS) and Open API policy that was notified by MeitY in the year 2015.

4. To implement the HLC recommendations, all Ministries/Departments, are requested that appropriate directions be issued to the concerned officials to enable and complete the onboarding on Entity Locker and Publish relevant APIs on API Setu platform by:

- I. Onboarding and Enabling issuance of business-related official documents through **Entity Locker**
- II. Publishing the business and citizen centric APIs on **API Setu** for innovation and development of its service-related applications by the concerned stakeholders.
