

RESTRICTIONS ON SALE OF LIQUOR DURING BYE-ELECTION

Panaji: August 14, 2026

Department of Finance (Revenue & Control) has directed all licensed premises "for the sale of liquor" to remain closed from August 15, 2026 to August 17, 2026 within the areas under the jurisdiction of Ward No. I of Village Panchayat Chinchinim Deusua, Taluka Salcete, South Goa District in the State of Goa on account of Polling Day and Counting of Votes for the Bye-Election to vacant wards of Village Panchayat.

However, the licensed premises having license for "Bar and Restaurant" will be allowed to keep the restaurant open for serving food only and the bar counter shall be closed and no liquor shall be allowed to be served on the above mentioned days. The owners of the licensed premises having "Bar & Restaurant" shall also display a board in the premises stating that no liquor will be served and that only the restaurant is open for serving food.
